What is the DAP EPS?

The DAP-EPS is a patient-focused web site designed to empower you with online access to your personal diagnostic information. Rather than waiting and not knowing what's going on, the DAP-EPS lets you see important information in a timely way and helps you keep track of everything.

How can I use the DAP-EPS?

Once you sign up to use the DAP-EPS, you will be able to:

- Look at your appointments
- See a Diagnostic Pathway Map, which shows each step of the diagnostic process and can tell you what your next steps might be
- Know who is on your care team by showing you a list of who your healthcare providers are, including their contact information
- Invite your friends and family to also use the web site and follow along with you

How will my healthcare provider use the DAP-EPS?

Your healthcare provider will also be using the DAP-EPS. They use a special 'provider' version of the web site and will see everything you see, such as:

- Information about your appointments
- If your test results are available
- Details that allow them to monitor your progress


