How will I get my appointment?

The appointment for the Ultrasound and Laboratory blood work will be given to you by Dr. Siren's office.

Health Card

Be prepared to present your health card at every visit.

Where to find us?

To find the Ultrasound Department follow these instructions:

- Enter the Health Sciences Centre using the Main Entrance
- Follow the main corridor, past the Information Desk, Robin's Donuts and Season's Shop
- Turn right when you get to the Main Staircase
- Follow this corridor, past the Patient Unit 2A, Ambulatory Care waiting room and the patient Unit 2B
- Immediately after 2B turn right again and here you will enter the Diagnostic Imaging's (X-Ray) main waiting room

What to do?

You will be pre-registered therefore go straight into the Ultrasound Waiting room, **you do not have to go to the main registration desk**. The Technologist will be waiting for you to get your Ultrasound test done.

What is my next step?

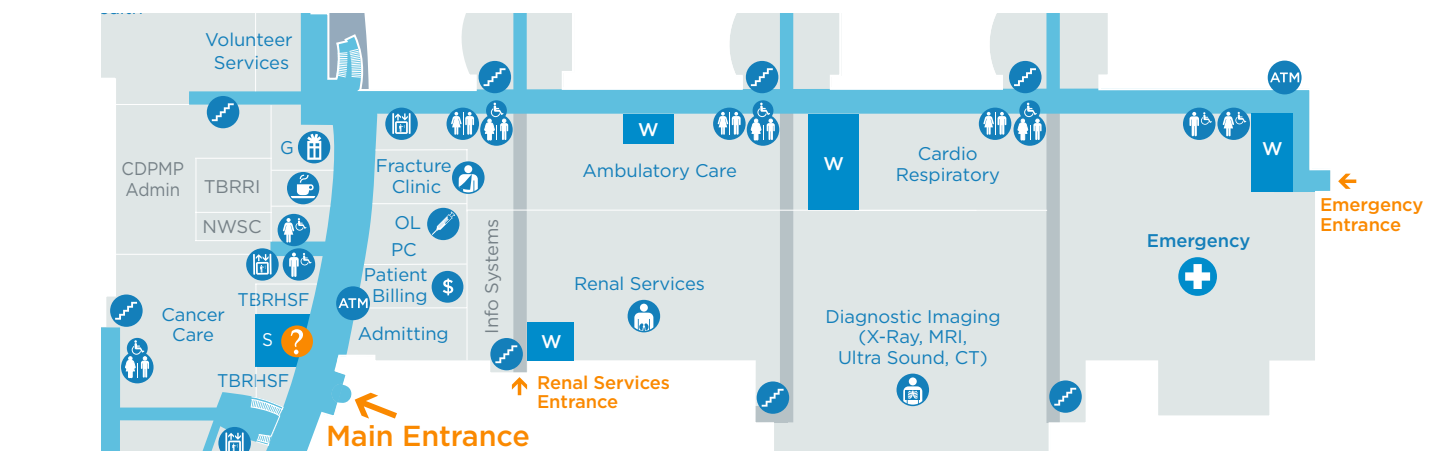
Once the Ultrasound test is complete you will be directed to **immediately** report to the Laboratory Out-patient area (across from Robin's Donuts). You will present yourself to the side window.

On the weekend the Ultrasound Technologist will page a phlebotomist to come to the Ultrasound Department to take your blood.

Where to find the Laboratory?

To find the Laboratory Out-patient Department follow these instructions:

- When leaving the Diagnostic Imaging (X-Ray) waiting room, turn left and go pass Patient Unit 2B, Ambulatory Care Waiting Room and Patient Unit 2A
- Turn left by the Season's Gift Shop and you will find the Laboratory Out-Patient Department across from Robin's Donuts coffee shop.
