Registered Dietitians (RDs) are regulated health professionals who are uniquely trained food and nutrition experts. They are the recognized experts in translating scientific, medical and nutrition information into practical advice to help individuals, their families and communities to access nutrition for health. Collaboration with clients, caregivers, and other health professionals is central to dietetic practice whether the RD works in a private practice or as a member of a health care team. Together, they manage nutrition for health promotion, disease prevention, and treatment of acute and chronic diseases.
