Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre (TBRHSC) is seeking a Medical Oncologist/Hematologist (preferred) or Medical Oncologist to join our Regional Cancer Program in Northwestern Ontario.

TBRHSC is the sole tertiary hospital servicing all of Northwestern Ontario with a catchment population of approximately 250,000. The city of Thunder Bay offers a perfect balance of urban and rural life including affordable housing, excellent schooling at all levels and incredible outdoor opportunities for the healthy living enthusiast. Thunder Bay provides a vibrant, culturally diverse community with access to fine dining and the arts, all of which make this community a wonderful place to live, work, or raise a family.

The Regional Cancer Program in Northwestern Ontario is located in the state-of-the-art Cancer Centre on the campus of TBRHSC. The program provides a full continuum of cancer services for the residents of Northwestern Ontario. The team includes 6 Medical Oncologists/Haematologists, 4 Radiation Oncologists, 1 GP Oncologist and a Palliative Care Specialist. Team members participate in clinical trials, clinical research and teaching opportunities with the Northern Ontario School of Medicine (NOSM) and the Thunder Bay Regional Research Institute (TBRI). This position is funded through an Alternate Funding Plan (AFP) with the Ontario Medical Oncologist Association (ONTMOA).

The Medical Oncology Program has approximately 1200 new patient visits each year. The program treats all major disease sites and provides supervision for patients receiving treatment in 13 Regional Satellite Clinics throughout the region. The Cancer Program is a paperless environment employing Mosaic as our Electronic Medical Record.

Preferred candidates will possess:

- Certificate of registration for a valid license to practice in the province of Ontario issued by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario
- FRCP in Internal Medicine with subspecialty training in Medical Oncology, or equivalent qualifications
- Additional Fellowship training would be advantageous
