## Pathologist Opportunities

Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre (TBRHSC) is seeking a General or Anatomical Pathologist to join our Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine.

TBRHSC is a 395 funded bed, state of the art, acute care facility and home to the Northwestern Ontario Regional Cancer Centre and the Thunder Bay Regional Research Institute. We are also affiliated with the Northern Ontario School of Medicine. We serve a catchment population of 250,000.

Our Pathologists provide direction and supervision of clinical laboratory services, including a testing volume of approximately 1.5 million per year. Anatomical pathology services include over 18,000 surgical pathology cases supported by histochemical and immunoperoxidase staining protocols, approximately 4,000 cytology cases and approximately 150 autopsies with approximately 90% being medicolegal cases per year.

Pathologists share in the daily service responsibilities and in the evening and weekend call rotations. The Department also provides consultation services for regional health care providers.

The preferred candidate will have certification in General or Anatomical Pathology, with capabilities in hematopathology and bone marrows and also be licensed, or eligible for a license to practice in Ontario. Compensation will be in accordance with the Laboratory Medicine Physician Funding Agreement with the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care, a combination of Fee For Service Billings and Alternate Payment Plan (APP).
