Radiation Oncologist

Permanent Full-Time

Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre (TBRHSC) is the sole tertiary hospital servicing all of Northwestern Ontario with a catchment population of approximately 250,000. The city of Thunder Bay offers a perfect balance of urban and rural life including affordable housing, excellent schooling at all levels and incredible outdoor opportunities for the healthy living enthusiast. Thunder Bay provides a vibrant, culturally diverse community with access to fine dining and the arts, all of which make this community a wonderful place to live, work, or raise a family.

The Regional Cancer Program in Northwestern Ontario is in the state-of-the-art Cancer Centre on the campus of Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre (TBRHSC). The program provides a full continuum of cancer services for the residents of Northwestern Ontario. The Northwest Regional Cancer Program is one of 13 Regional Cancer Programs created by Cancer Care Ontario to ensure cancer care is delivered according to province-wide quality standards. The TBRHSC is the sole tertiary hospital servicing Northwestern Ontario, an area with a catchment population of approximately 250,000 but encompassing roughly half the land mass of Ontario.

The team includes 4 Radiation Oncologists, 7 Medical Oncologists/Haematologists, 1 GP Oncologist and 1 Palliative Care Specialist. Team members participate in clinical trials, clinical research and teaching opportunities with the Northern Ontario School of Medicine (NOSM).

The Radiation Oncology Program has approximately 950 new patient visits each year. The radiation treatment program is equipped with two Elekta Infinity accelerators equipped with Agility multi-leaf collimators, a Philips Gemini TF PET-CT simulator, and a Varian GammaMed plus high dose rate brachytherapy system. Brachytherapy treatments are delivered in a fully shielded operating room. Simulation and treatment planning are accomplished using Elekta's Monaco and XiO systems, and Mosaik is radiation oncology information system that is the backbone of the electronic medical record (EMR). The Cancer Program is a paperless environment employing Mosaik as our EMR. Radiation Oncology makes use of protocol driven careplans within the electronic environment.

Preferred candidates will be certified in Radiation Oncology by the Royal College of Physicians of Canada (FRCPC) and have a research background and academic rank. The successful applicant must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
