1. PURPOSE

To clarify NW Region Base Hospital process for paramedic decertification

2. **DEFINITIONS**

- i. Paramedic: as defined in subsection 1(1) of the Ambulation Act Ontario Regulation 257/00
- ii. <u>Primary Care Paramedic (PCP):</u> as defined in subsection 8 (1) of the Ambulation Act Ontario Regulation 257/00
- iii. <u>Advanced Care Paramedics (ACP):</u> defined in subsection 8 (2) of the Ambulation Act Ontario Regulation 257/00
- iv. <u>Decertification:</u> means the revocation, by the Medical Director, of a Paramedic's Certification
- v. <u>Medical Director:</u> means a physician designated by a Regional Base Hospital as the Medical Director of the Regional Base Hospital Program

3. PROCEDURE

- i. The Medical Director of the Base Hospital may request a decertification review at their discretion following a thorough investigation of an incident.
- ii. A request for a paramedic decertification review may only be authorized by the Medical Director of the Base Hospital.
- iii. The Base Hospital will comply with the MOHLTC Maintenance of Certification Policy for Decertification.
