Occupational Therapist

Occupational Therapists (OTs) are regulated healthcare professionals who help people learn or re-learn to manage the everyday activities and roles that are important to them (e.g. caring for themselves or others, caring for their home, participating in paid/unpaid work and leisure activities). The scope of practice of occupational therapy is the assessment of function and adaptive behaviour and the treatment and prevention of disorders which affect function or adaptive behaviour to develop, maintain, rehabilitate or augment function or adaptive behaviour in the areas of self-care, productivity and leisure. 1991, c. 33, s.3.

Occupational therapy is the art and science of enabling engagement in everyday living, through occupation; of enabling people to perform the occupations that foster health and well-being; and of enabling a just and inclusive society so that all people may participate to their potential in the daily occupations of life (Townsend & Polatajko, 2013, p. 380).
