Respiratory Therapists (RTs) are regulated health professionals who monitor, evaluate and treat individuals with respiratory and cardio-respiratory disorders. Respiratory Therapists are an essential part of the cardiac arrest team, are leaders in the use of mechanical ventilators and other life support equipment, and use medications, therapies and tests to assist in the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of heart and lung disease. Whenever and wherever breathing is an issue, Respiratory Therapists are there to provide care.
