

Cardiology Technologist

Cardiology Technologists are health professionals who conduct required non-invasive diagnostic cardiology procedures in electrocardiograms, ambulatory monitoring, exercise stress testing, and other advanced diagnostic procedures. While most Cardiology Technologists work in acute care hospitals, some work in physician's offices, medical and diagnostic laboratories, cardiac rehabilitation centers and outpatient centers. Employment opportunities for Cardiology Technologists is expected to increase over the coming years due to the aging population as older people tend to have more incidences of heart problems; the increase will be more towards specialty areas such as pacemaker clinics, stress testing, Holter monitoring, and electrophysiology (arrhythmia) labs.
