Medical Radiation Technologist -Radiation Therapist



A Medical Radiation Technologist is a regulated health professional who uses radiation or electromagnetism to produce diagnostic images of a patient's body or who administers radiation to treat patients for certain medical conditions on the order of a physician or other authorized health professional.

Radiation Therapists are part of an interdisciplinary health care team that plan and deliver the prescribed radiation treatment, as well as tending to the needs of the patient receiving this treatment. The Radiation Therapist, who sees the patient each day during his or her course of therapy, is the vital link for the patient to access the many services provided in a cancer treatment centre.
