Psychologists and Psychological Associates are regulated health professionals who are trained in the assessment, diagnosis, treatment and prevention of behavioural and mental health conditions. In addition, Psychologists and Psychological Associates use a variety of approaches directed toward the maintenance and enhancement of physical, intellectual, emotional, social and interpersonal functioning.

Some Psychologists and Psychological Associates work primarily as researchers and faculty at universities and at governmental and non-governmental organizations. Others work primarily as practitioners in hospitals, schools, clinics, correctional facilities, employee assistance programs, and private offices. Many Psychologists and Psychological Associates are active in both research and practice.

Psychologists and Psychological Associates engage in research, practice, and teaching across a wide range of topics having to do with how people think, feel, and behave. Their work can involve individuals, groups, and families as well as larger organizations in government and industry.
