A nurse is a regulated health professional who utilizes skill, knowledge and judgment to apply relevant practice standards and guidelines to assess, plan, and implement care for patients in various health care settings. At Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre (TBRHSC) we have nurses and nurse practitioners working in inpatient, outpatient and community-based departments.

A nurse practitioner (NP) is a Registered Nurse with advanced university education who provides personalized, quality health care to patients. Ontario Nurse Practitioners provide a full range of health care services to individuals, families and communities in a variety of settings including hospitals.
